ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION

Photo Identification:

Non-Photo Identification:

Birth Certificate

Health Cards cannot be accepted for identification purposes under the Health Cards and Numbers Control Act, 1991 section 2.2(1).

Social Insurance Cards cannot be accepted for identification.

If an applicant does not have any photo identification, they should complete an "Affidavit of Identity" form which they must have completed and notarized, either by a Notary Public, Judge, Lawyer or Doctor. Someone who can confirm that this person is who they say they are.
